LICENSING OF GREENHOUSE VEGETABLE PRODUCERS

Administration for the renewal of greenhouse vegetable producer licenses has commenced. The current licensing period ends November 1, 2011 and, when issued, renewed licenses will correspond to the November 2, 2011 – November 1, 2012 licensing period.

Recently, producer license renewal information was sent to each producer via the regular post. Producers are to complete and return the application form to arrive at the VMC office accompanied by the annual producer license fee of \$100.00 by no later than November 1, 2011.

Late arriving annual license renewal forms will result in issuance of a Class II annual producer license. This class of license has an annual license fee of \$500.00.

Producers are encouraged to complete and return the producer license renewal application form without delay. If the producer license renewal information has not arrived by the end of September contact the VMC office - telephone: 604-542-9734.

- ❖ 2010 AgriStability/AgriInvest Harmonized Form **without Penalty September 30, 2011**
- ❖ 2010 AgriStability/AgriInvest Harmonized Form **with Penalty December 31, 2011**

Note: *Producers' receiving benefits will have their payment reduced by \$500.00/mo. to a maximum of \$1500.00*
